## Benoflex

### Description:

Benoflex is a colourless liquid, that is dissolvable with water. Benoflex is not flammable and contains no oils or dissolving agents, that is hazardous at vaporous state

### Usage:

Benoflex is a water-based, odourless release agent, which causes no discolouration of the concrete. It is used in the production of block pavers.

### Advantages:

Benoflex is very financially beneficial.  
Benoflex causes no discolouration of the concrete.  
Benoflex leaves a smooth surface.

### Dosage:

Benoflex should be applied with spraying equipment.  
Benoflex is mixed with water 1:7.  
We recommend using nozzles with a small liquid consumption.

### Limitations:

May not be mixed with other products and must be stored above freezing point.
